



Collection Process

- Ages 21-24 collect 1 Thinprep vial in the usual fashion.
- Ages 25-65 collect 2 Thinprep vials in the usual fashion.

If History of Hysterectomy

- If indication was HSIL or cancer, screen Q3 years for 20 years.
- Otherwise, no screening required.

Abbreviations/Definitions

- LSIL: low grade squamous intraepithelial lesion
- HSIL: high grade squamous intraepithelial lesion
- ASCUS: atypical squamous cells of undetermined significance
- AGC: atypical glandular cells
- ASC-H: atypical squamous cells cannot exclude high grade
